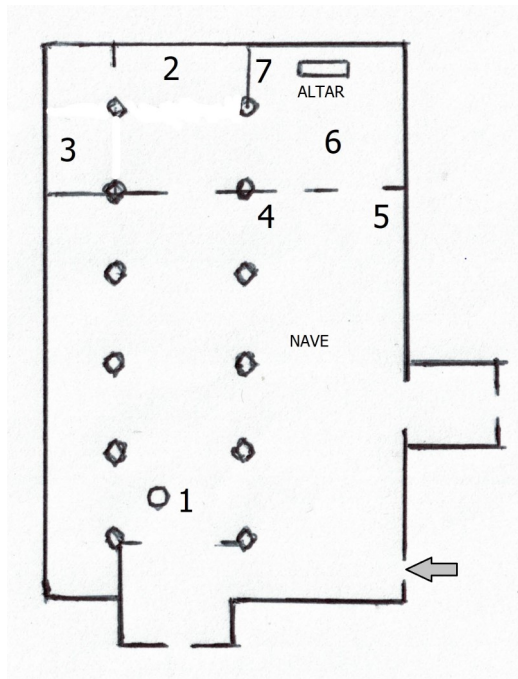

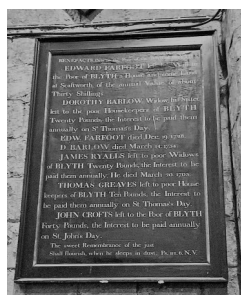
The diamond-shaped panels on the west wall are hatchments belonging to the Mellish family.
